Mandated and funded by the Workforce Investment Act, our quality, on-site outplacement services provide an effective and smooth transition to new employment for all affected employees. We are working in collaboration with The Massachusetts Fisherman's Partnership, The Fishing Partnership Support Services, The New Bedford Career Center, The Greater New Bedford Workforce Investment Board, The City of New Bedford, as well as the Cape & The Islands Workforce Investment Board, The North Shore Career Centers, The North Shore Workforce Investment Board, The City of Gloucester, to provide reemployment assistance to those affected by the May 1, 2013 Fishing Limits.

Rapid Response is a federally funded program established through a grant from the Department of Labor to provide assistance to companies and their employees who are downsizing.
