On Thursday, October 24, 2013, a free safety and survival training will be held at the U.S. Coast Guard Station in Gloucester from 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM. The hands-on training, sponsored by Fishing Partnership Support Services, is conducted by Coast Guard certified fishing vessel safety instructors.
