New England Fishery Council Seeks Enforcement Advisory Panel Applicants

Applications must be submitted to the Council office no later than 5:00 p.m. EST on 2/21/2014

The New England Fishery Management Council (NEFMC) is seeking applicants to serve for three years on its Enforcement Advisory Panel (AP), from March 2014 through December 2016. Panel members will be asked to provide information and guidance to specific oversight committees and make recommendations to the Council during the development of federal fishery management plans, as well as for amendments and framework adjustments to the NEFMC's existing plans. Advisors also may be asked to provide input about special issues or problems.

The Council is specifically looking for active commercial fishermen to fill three vacancies on the Enforcement AP. Advisory Panel members will include individuals who are interested in the conservation and management of a fishery or group of fisheries under Council management. To the extent possible, the panels will reflect various areas of expertise and interests, including geography and gear types, user groups and a range of social and economic perspectives. The New England Council will reimburse advisors from the New England region for travel expenses.

Panels are limited to a maximum of 15 members. Individuals may serve on more than one panel. *Current advisors do not need to indicate their interest if they wish to remain on an advisory panel*.

Following a review by the Enforcement Committee, the NEFMC's Executive Committee will make final decisions on applications. Nominees will be subject to an additional level of review by NOAA's Office of Law Enforcement. Applications may be declined because of a marine resource violation.
