Dear Governor Pence and Mr. Ross:

We are joining with our colleagues in the commercial fishing industry and in the businesses that are dependent on commercial fishing to strongly support Chris Oliver's appointment as Assistant Administrator for NOAA Fisheries.

After too many years of what has been at best lukewarm support from the U.S. Department of Commerce our industry needs someone with Mr. Oliver's knowledge, experience and attitude to allow us to sustainably harvest fish and shellfish from the some of the world's most productive fishing grounds in our Exclusive Economic Zone. Today the proportion of domestically produced seafood is under ten percent of the total seafood consumption in the U.S. We are confident that with Mr. Oliver's leadership at NOAA Fisheries we will be able increase production and regain markets that we have lost over the past eight years, and we are as confident as well that we can do it sustainably.

This letter accompanies a similar letter from some of our colleagues that lists six reasons why they are supporting Mr. Oliver. Their reasons are our reasons so we won't bother to reiterate them. Mr. Oliver's support extends from Maine through the Gulf of Mexico to Alaska, includes fishermen from the smallest vessels to the largest and onshore businesses that handle domestically produced seafood from the dock to the consumer.
